Buddy System (one month)

- *P2 students are paired up with P1 students*
- *familiar face to look for so that they feel more secured*
- *Show them the school routines and places they need to know.*



School Rules and Regulations

- *School rules designed to ensure a safe and healthy physical and social environment. Do's and Don'ts found in Student Handbook and school website.*
- *Parents are urged to understand and ensure adherence to school rules*
- *Counselling and reasoning are used to manage students.*
- *The important point is that the students must learn from their mistake and not repeat it.*

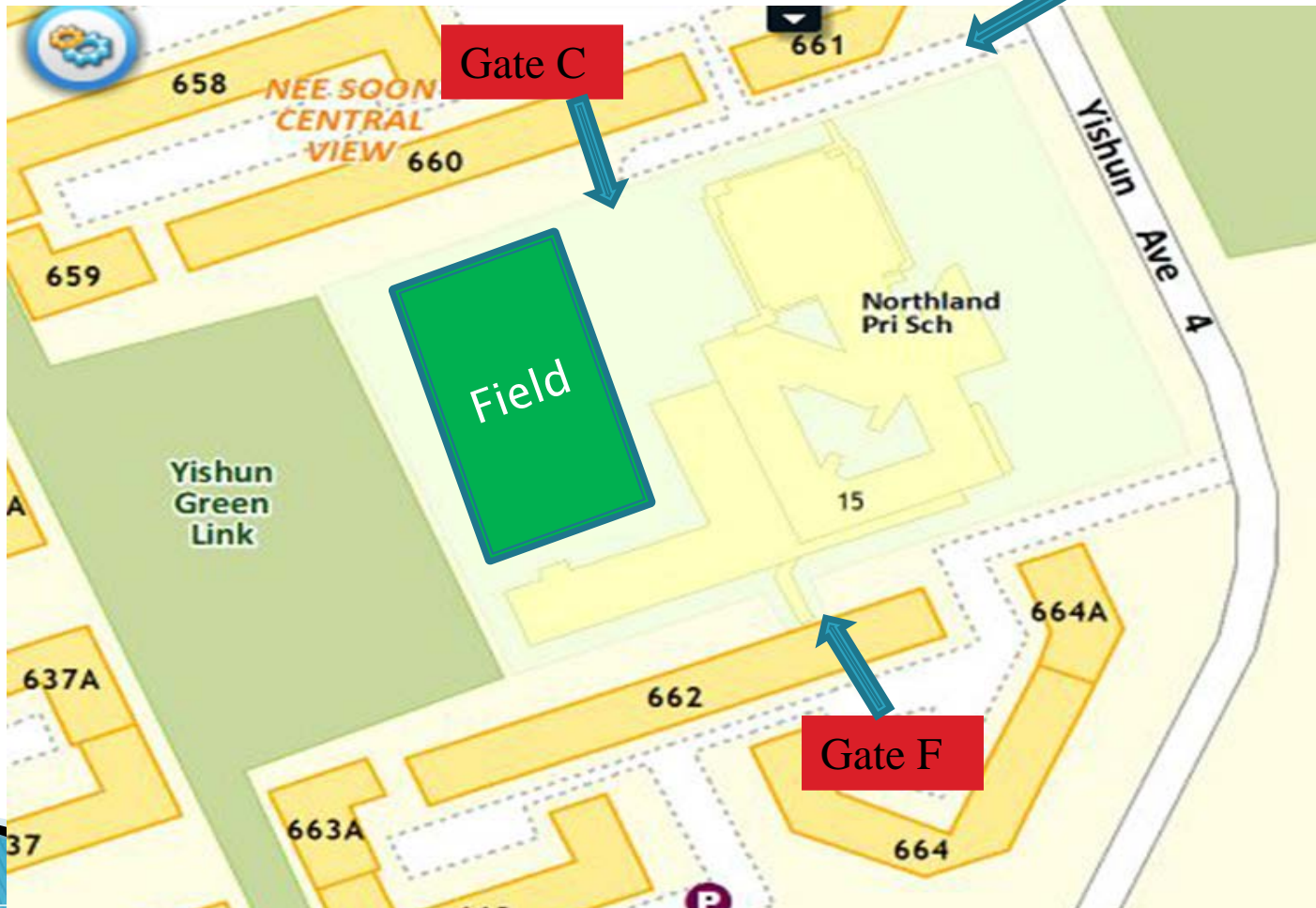
It is important to inform the children where the meeting point is to avoid confusion and reduce anxiety especially on the first few days.

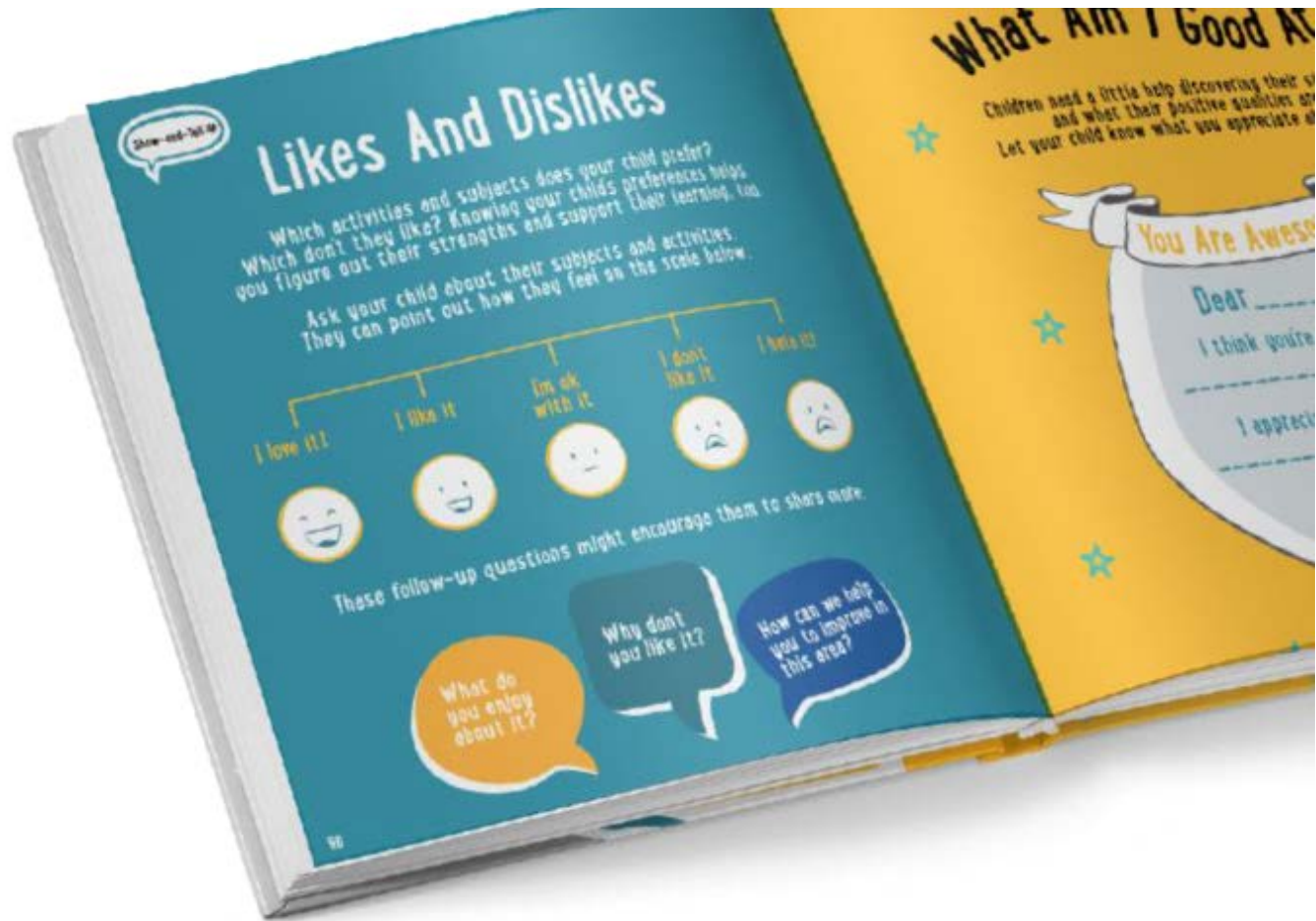
