3. Gifted Education Programme (GEP) Identification Exercise 2018

Students for the GEP are selected through two rounds of tests: the Screening Test (first round) and the Selection Test (second round).

The tentative schedule for the two rounds of the GEP Identification Exercise is given below:

The GEP Screening and Selection Exercises will be based on the Primary 1 to 3 English and Mathematics syllabuses. Please also note the following:

- a) Screening Exercise (Mathematics)
All topics in the P3 Mathematics syllabus are included except 'Area and Perimeter', 'Geometry' and 'Time'.
- b) Selection Exercise (Mathematics)
All topics in the P3 Mathematics syllabus are included except 'Angles' and 'Perpendicular and Parallel lines' in the topic of Geometry.

4. Conversational Chinese & Malay (CCM) Programme
